



Hello,

This week we've been looking at E-safety - staying safe online. This has formed part of our termly programme of *safety weeks* and has coincided with national Safer Internet Day. A key theme of our e-safety week has been 'permissions'.

We looked at all the times you might be asked to give your permission for something when you are online and how to carefully consider whether to give your permission or not. The children were made aware that they shouldn't give away personal information - like their full name or address - to anyone online especially if they don't really know who is asking.

We reminded them that to stay safe online they should also be asking permission from the trusted adults (parents / carers / teachers) before they make any choices about what they do online. That way, we can make sure they are staying safe. Our older children also considered the impact of sharing information about others online without their permission and the impact this can have on them and others.

These safety weeks are a great way for us to regularly discuss with children how to stay safe in the modern world but we are also very conscious that staying safe online can feel like a 24/7 job.

If you are ever worried about your child's safety online please do come and talk to a member of staff as we're always here to help.
