Dear Parents and carers,

I am writing to you with an update regarding the information we are receiving about the coronavirus.

We are receiving regular updates from the Local Authority and Public Health England regarding the coronavirus and how schools should be managing the situation.

The current advice is that schools should remain open and that children are safe to attend school.

Additional advice:

- Staff and children who have returned from Iran, specific lockdown areas in northern Italy, special care zones in South Korea or Hubei province China should self-isolate and not attend school for 14 days. From our current checks, we are not aware that this applies to any member of our school community.
- If any child, or member of staff, begins to develop any symptoms of coronavirus, then they should inform the school and let us know if they have travelled to any other countries in the last 14 days. Afterwards they should stay at home to stop the infection spreading.
- If anyone thinks that they, or their child, has symptoms of coronavirus they should call NHS 111.

I have attached, with this letter, some information and guidance from Public Health England.

As a school, we will continue to promote good personal hygiene. This is something that our 'well-being warriors' focused on last term and every year group had an assembly on hand washing.

If you have any concerns, please do feel free to contact the school to discuss them further.

We will also keep you informed if the current advice for schools changes.
