

Inquiry

This term the children will finish learning about the Stone Age by looking at the monument Stonehenge. They will then be learning all about rocks. The children will be learning about the 3 different types of rocks. They will learn how rocks change and learn the processes that form each.

They will also look at erosion, weathering and the movements of tectonic plates.

We will end the term looking at light.

The children will learn where light comes from and why we have day and night. They will learn about reflective materials and how shadows are foamed.

English

This term we will use the story 'King Midas and the Golden Touch' to explore how to include description in a piece of writing. We will be looking at explanation texts in our non-fiction writing later in the term.

Children will begin the term looking back at fractions. They will revisit adding and subtracting fractions and equivalent fractions. They will then move on to learn how to find fractions of amounts.
