

Please complete a reading activity with your child at least three times a week. This can be a mixture of reviewing sounds, practising the common exception words or reading their book. When your child is reading their decodable book please encourage them to track each word with their magic finger.

If you have any questions regarding reading or any specific questions regarding your child's progress please talk to their class teacher.

Moon Class - Our PE session has moved, we are now doing PE on Wednesdays.

Times table rock stars: Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS) is a great online resource that will support your child with recalling their times tables fluently. Weekly TTRS Sessions are set by your child's teacher, for your child to complete at home. Each week in celebration assembly a child in each class is awarded a TTRS certificate. Please can you support your child by providing time for them to access TTRS. If you have not got your child's login details, please speak to their class teacher.

Jupiter Class - Jupiter's timetable has changed for this week moving forward. This means that we now have INDOOR PE on a Monday and OUTDOOR PE on a Wednesday. Our library day is still the same but we know have a regular short ICT session on a Tuesday.



Aquila Class - Just a quick email to say that we have a new timetable that has started this week, that means library and PE days have changed...nothing too exciting really.
